We have been notified that insurance will not cover the damages to our roof. The church board voted this week to allocate up to \$10,000 for replacing the scuppers. These are the drainage system allowing water to flow off the roof into the drainage pipes. We are hopeful that this will resolve the roof leaks. But if leaks persist, we have voted up to \$80,000 to replace the fellowship hall section of the roof. Thank you for your donations to the roof fund! The balance of the money for this project will be funded from church reserves due to our diligent savings.
