## Pastor's Note

June 8, 2019

Summer vacation is here and that means that summer heat is making its entrance. As we begin this season of sunshine, sand, and outdoor activity, there is one thing that is crucial for a successful summer; water. I'm not talking about ocean waves or swimming pools; I am talking about the water we drink. A study by New York Hospital-Cornell Medical Center showed that as many as 75% of Americans are chronically dehydrated. The truth is that thirst is not an indication of the body's anticipated future need of water but our thirst means that we already have a lack of water. To put it more simply, thirst indicates dehydration, and most of us are dehydrated. Dehydration can cause fatigue, foggy memory, irritability, decreased metabolism, and increased risk of kidney stones. Moderate to severe dehydration can be cause for hospitalization. Here's the point; water is essential, but it is not only essential it is desirable. We certainly need it, but when we are thirsty we want it. Or at least we should. Today we will continue with the theme from last week's sermon and explore Christ's invitation to the thirsty. It is an invitation not to the satisfied and content, but to those who are missing something, lacking something, searching, desiring, and longing for something more. To those, Christ's arms are outstretched, and He says "If any one thirsts, let him come to Me and drink."

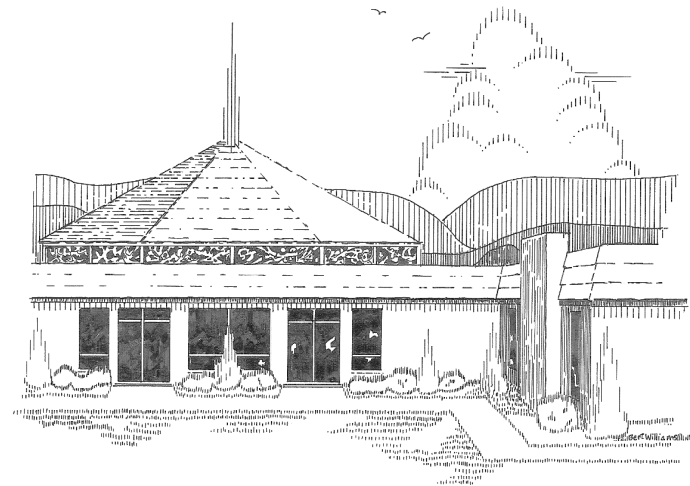
