Which of course brings up the question: What will the New Year be like?

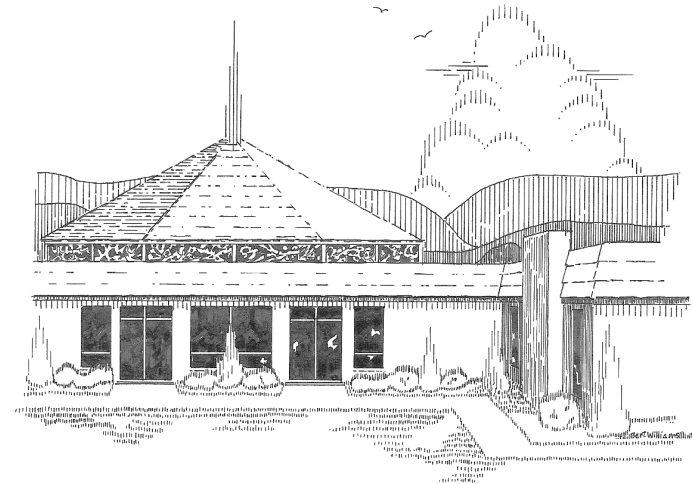
