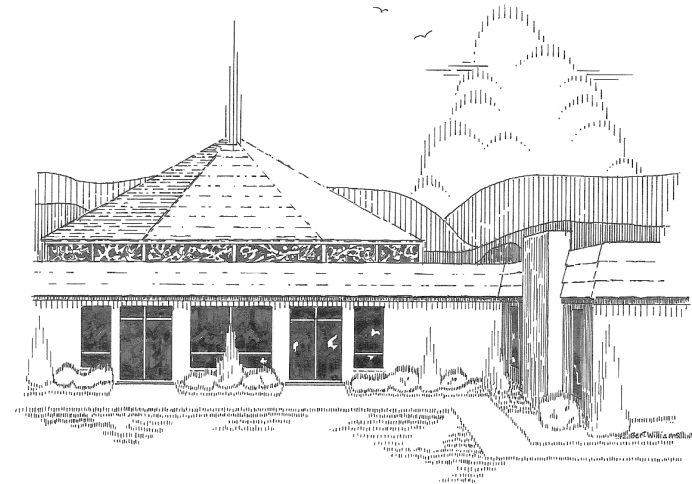
# From Our Pastor
