Pastor's Note

July 17, 2021

Good morning and welcome to the New Market Seventh-day Adventist Church! We are honored to have you with us today, either in person or online. Thank you for worshipping with us!

Today is our foot washing and communion service. If you're a guest with us and are unfamiliar with these things, allow me to explain briefly what will happen.

Most of today's worship service will follow the normal pattern. However, after a shorter-than-normal sermon, we will divide up into different rooms to wash one another's feet. Sounds strange, doesn't it? But it's actually a very ancient practice, going back nearly 2,000 years to a time described in John 13 in the Bible when Jesus washed His disciples' feet. This ceremony is deep in meaning and significance, some of which I'll be talking about in my sermon.

After the foot washing, we will return to the church sanctuary for the communion service. There, bread and unfermented grape juice will be served. The bread represents Christ's body, which was sacrificed for our sins on the cross. The unfermented juice represents the pure, unspoiled blood that Jesus gave on the cross for our sins to be forgiven and removed.

I will guide you during the service so you know when to take the bread and juice, respectively. And whether you're a Seventh-day Adventist or not, if you are a believer in Jesus, then you are welcome to participate with us in these symbols and in the foot washing.

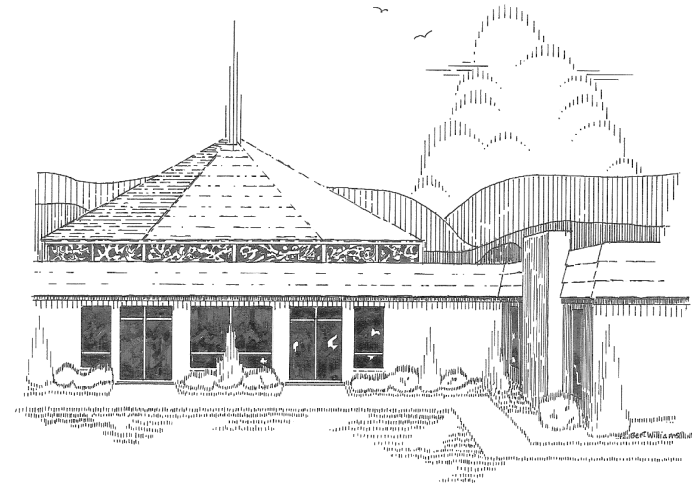
