Sign of the Times

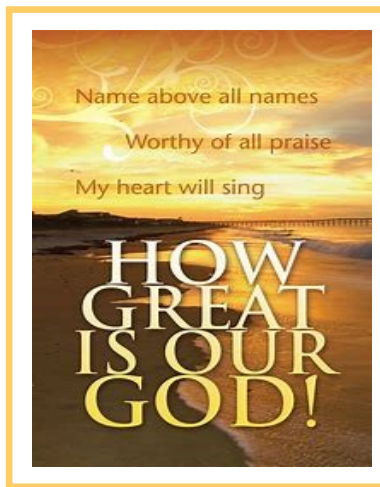

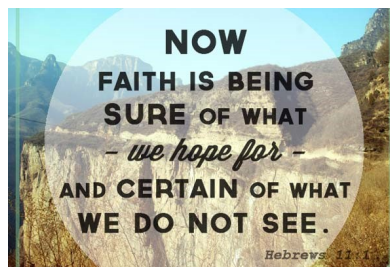
